A remarkable, God-centered education for the youth of the city.

As we begin our sixteenth year, our mission in the city is more urgent than ever. Amidst adversity and a growing achievement gap, urban parents continue to sacrifice to send their kids to a school with Christ at the center.

Today, beyond my wildest dreams, Hope Academy is serving 425 inner-city students K-12 (74% of whom are living near or below poverty). Academic achievement at Hope is almost three times greater than our neighborhood schools. 95% of our first four graduating classes have been accepted to two- and four-year colleges.

Our next step of faith is widening the admissions funnel, starting by doubling our kindergarten from two classes to four. Lord willing, this step of faith will allow us to serve 520 students by 2020. Please join me in praying and considering how God might be calling you to help grow hope for more youth in our city.

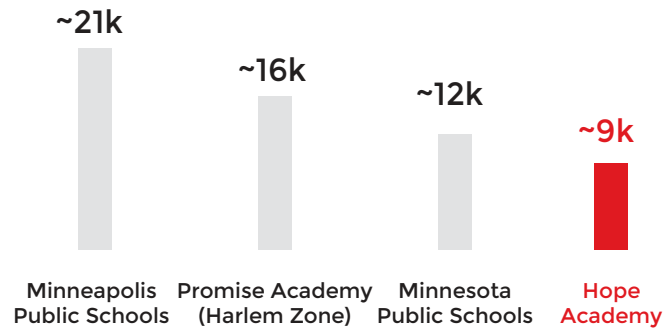




THE HOPE ACADEMY MODEL

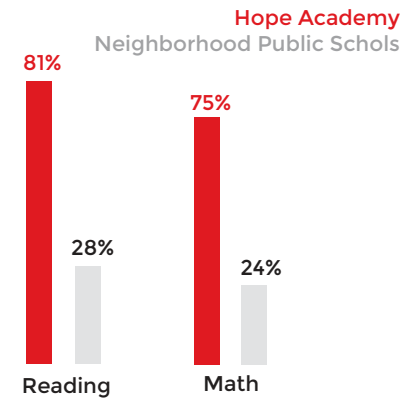
COMPARING COST PER STUDENT

School cost per student each year.



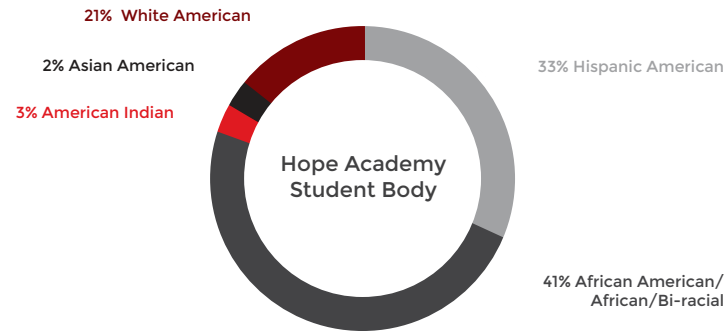
DYNAMITE RESULTS

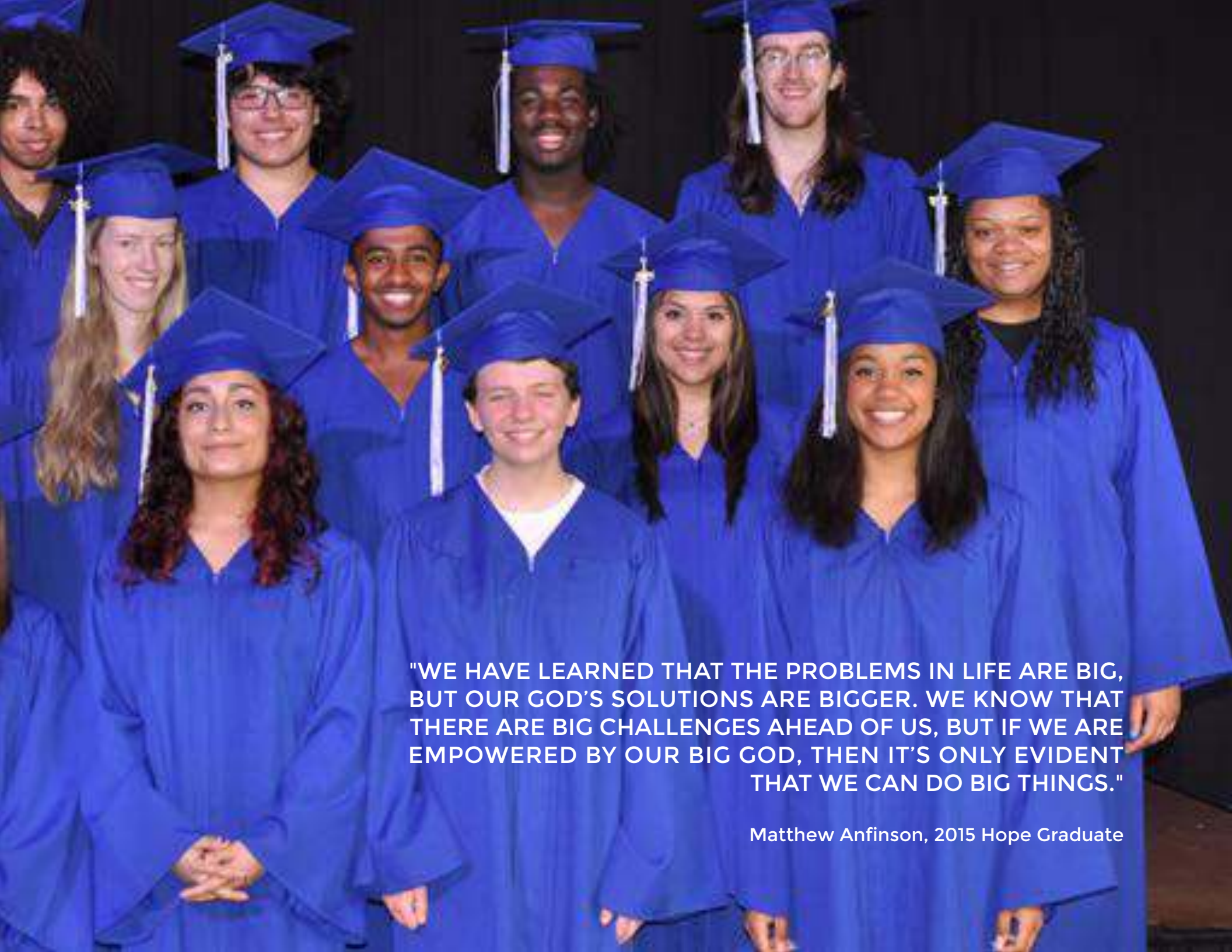

Adam's Story



Adam's father abused him as a child. We immediately sought shelter as soon as I learned. Because of the abuse, Adam had a speech delay and severe behavioral problems. I wondered if he could ever become a normal kid.

When it came time for Kindergarten, I asked a friend if she knew of any good schools in the area. She mentioned Hope Academy. I looked into the school, and it was a perfect fit.

Adam's kindergarten teacher embraced us. When she learned about our situation, she and her husband stepped up and took a personal interest in Adam. Soon, his sponsors did the same. Their support has turned Adam's life around.

In the years since, the teachers, sponsors, and staff at Hope Academy have helped fill the place of the father Adam never had. The school took in not just Adam, but our whole family.

Through Hope, God has come to us in a big way. Adam is now a whole, happy, confident, smart kid. I want to say thank you, from the bottom of my heart.

NEW CITY, NEW LIFE

Karen's Story



I was a mother abusing drugs and alcohol. If I hadn't left Chicago when I did, I'd either be dead or in jail.

Upon arriving in Minneapolis, I was homeless and jobless. Aaron began attending a tutoring class at our church. His tutors encouraged us to apply to Hope Academy. I asked "What's that?" They told me all about Hope.

Hope nurtured Aaron's intelligence and has taken him beyond his wildest dreams. Every day he comes home talking: "Mrs. Pearce that, Mr. Calcote this, Mr. Brown that!"

As withdrawals ceased and the drugs left my body, Aaron's success at Hope Academy and renewed faith, filled my wounds.

Six years later, Aaron has received 5 honor roll certificates. He has many friends. Hope Academy is our new family. I'm a new woman, celebrating seven years sober. If you are a Hope Academy partner, hear me: you will never know how deeply appreciated your help has been. You made a new life possible for us.

GARBAGE DUMPS TO GRADUATION Ephraim's Story



I grew up as an orphan in Ethiopia. It was not uncommon for me to go door-to-door seeking scraps, eating out of garbage dumps. Begging for money. Stealing.

My brother and I were adopted by a family in America. My age placed me in eighth grade, but academically I was three grades behind. After just one year of very hard work at Hope Academy, I was promoted from fifth grade to the eighth grade class the next fall.

I was never a Christian in Ethiopia. But watching how my teachers, family, and friends poured into me opened my eyes to God.

Today, I am on a new walk as a Christ-follower. I am called not to be served, but to serve.

A big part of my past is how people have poured into my life. Now, I want to do the same. Lord willing, I will someday return to Ethiopia to bring hope to the orphans of my homeland.

FROM SUCCESS TO SIGNIFICANCE Doug's Story



Like most people during the first part of my life, I was focused primarily on SUCCESS - my education, career, marriage, raising a family, saving for retirement. But in my 50s, I reached "half-time" and my focus shifted from success to SIGNIFICANCE - how could I make a lasting impact on my community and the world around me? I wanted to reinvest my time, talents and treasures in building God's kingdom!

Soon after retiring from 3M, I attended a Tour of Hope and was immediately caught up in what the school was all about. What hooked me was watching a class of first graders recite the Hope Declaration with all the enthusiasm they could muster. I was sold! I knew this was where God wanted me to invest.

Since then, my wife (Kris) and I have become financial Partners at Hope. I volunteer every week in the 4th grade classroom as a teacher's aide and mentor two middle school boys. Kris supports the upper school speaker series called Athenaeum. For us, giving is receiving! Everything we do at Hope comes back to us as a blessing that we're truly making a difference in the world.

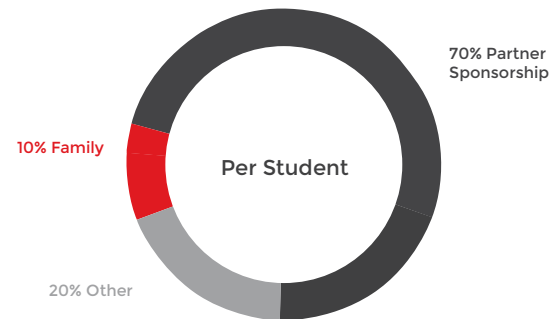

WIDENING THE FUNNEL

Hope Academy is growing from two sections of kindergarten to four sections, in order to serve 520 students by 2020.

GOAL 1:

Add classrooms to prepare Hope Academy's facility to serve 520 students. God has given us an amazing building to continue to grow into as the number of students we serve expands.

GOAL 2:

Grow scholarship partners for 200 more students. We are introducing others to our mission through monthly Tour of Hope events and our annual gala, An Evening of Hope.

GOAL 3:

Endow the education of 100 students with a new Legacy Partner Endowment Fund. Partners are investing in the future of inner-city youth through major gifts (\$50,000+) to the Legacy Partner Endowment Fund.

GOAL 4:

Ensure that Hope graduates can afford and navigate college. Our College Counseling team tracks our graduates and helps our high school students prepare for college.

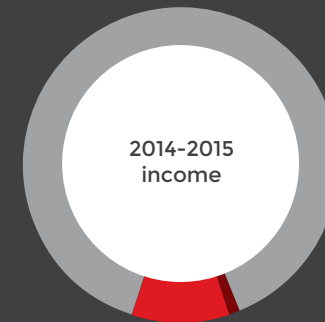

Non-capital giving during FY was \$3,584,759 and included gifts to both 14-15 and 15-16 AF, and gift allocations to capital & oper. reserve funds. **These are the final expenditures of our Goodness, Truth & Beauty Fund. ***This is Hope's share of our building expenses. Teen Challenge contributes an additional \$5/sf (approx. \$200k) to cover building costs. Hegenes Management manages Building Financials on behalf of Hope Academy, with all financials then combined at year end. NOTE: The figures here are meant to show the basic inflow and outflow of cash during our fiscal year. It does not include non-cash items like in-kind contributions, nor does it include the value of government services received like Title I and Title II. Hope conducts an annual audit of its finances (not finished at the time of publication). Complete audited financial statements are available for review. 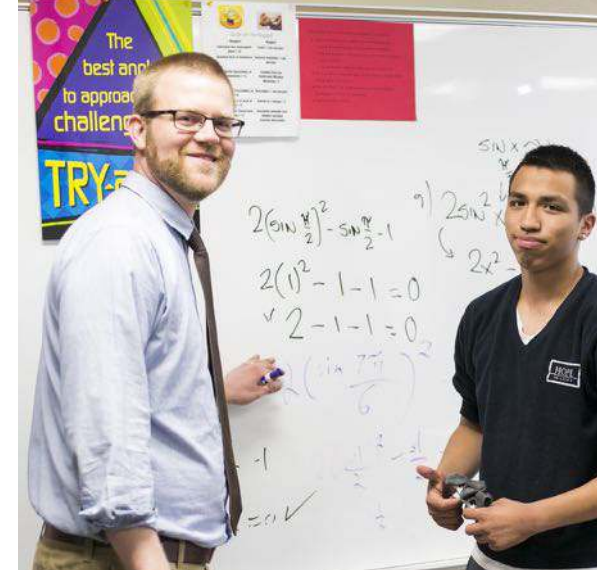
